



## Walk Day FAQ's

### Donations

#### **I have more donations to turn in...Can I bring them to the walk?**

Yes! Donations can be turned in at registration and will still count toward your incentive prizes and t-shirts. We will accept cash, checks, money orders, and credit cards at Registration.

### Pets

#### **Can I bring my dog to the event?**

Only if your dog is a service dog. All other fur-friends will need to stay home. There will be LA Live security around, so please be prepared to show service dog id.

### Picnic

#### **Can my team bring a canopy, tables and food for my team?**

LA Live is a different setting and atmosphere than our events in the past. Unfortunately, you will not be allowed to bring your personal canopies and picnic items. Some personal snacks and drinks are allowed, but not a picnic style set up. There are many places to eat before and after the event. So come early or stay after and enjoy LA Live! \*Remember those teams that raise \$2,500 or more by Thursday (before the event) will receive a canopy, table and chairs to use the day of the event!

### Food

#### **Will there be food and water?**

We will have some power bars and water available and through generous donations by our in-kind sponsors. Make sure to stop by the refreshment area and enjoy!

### Walk

#### **How long is the walk? What if I can't walk well or make it all the way?**

The walk is approx. 1.5 miles. We will be walking on the sidewalks around LA Live, Staples Center and LA Convention Center. We will need to obey and follow all pedestrian traffic laws. There will be DOT and volunteers to help direct us. Please be kind and follow their instructions. There is a short cut back into LA Live if you feel that you cannot make the full route. We will have entertainment taking place and a shaded area for those that choose to stay at the square.

### Parking

#### **Where do I park? How much is it?**

There are many options to park around LA Live. All lots are run by 3<sup>rd</sup> party companies and we have no control over location, quality or cost. We recommend carpooling with your team and all "pitch in". Cost can vary from \$7-20+. The LA Live parking lots are the most expensive and can cost up to \$30. *Please be prepared to pay for parking. We do not have validations.* While some lots have handicap parking, you may still have to walk to and from LA Live. Please see the map on the website for parking lot locations.

### Metro

#### **I want to take the Metro, where do I get off?**

Metro is a great alternative to driving and the Pico Station is the closest to the walk site. It stops across the street from the LA Convention Center/Staples Center. Use the link: <https://www.lalive.com/visitor-center/public-transportation> for more information on public transportation options.

## **T-Shirts & prizes**

### **I raised a lot of money! How do I get my incentive prize and t-shirt?**

Individuals that raise \$100 or more will receive a t-shirt as part of the Club 100 incentive. This will be given at the walk. Any individual that raises \$1,000 or more will receive a medal at registration at the walk. All other incentive prizes will be sent via TurnKey Promotions after the event. You will have more time to raise money and earn incentive prizes. You will get an email 2-3 weeks after the event with instructions on how to claim your prize.
